## **Minutes of a Public Hearing on 2018 Proposed Budgets Held November 21, 2017 6:45 p.m.**

### **CALL TO ORDER**

A Public Hearing on 2018 Proposed Budgets was called to order by Supervisor Alan Barron at 6:45 p.m. on Tuesday, November 21, 2017, in the Monroe Charter Township Hall, 4925 East Dunbar Road, Monroe County, Michigan.

### **PRESENTATION OF PROPOSED 2018 GENERAL FUND, SPECIAL REVENUE, CAPITAL PROJECTS AND DEBT SERVICE BUDGETS**

Supervisor Barron and Clerk Schnurr presented the proposed 2018 Budgets.

The proposed 2018 General Fund Budget incorporates projected revenues in the amount of \$3,431,914 and expenditures in the amount of \$3,431,914 for a proposed balanced budget.

### **EXPLANATION OF PROPOSED MILLAGE TO BE LEVIED ON 2017 TAX BILLS**

The millage to be levied on the 2017 winter tax bill is set at 3.7911 mills which will be used to fund the 2018 Budget. This is projected to generate \$1,401,102 which is \$58,198 less than the amended revenue for the 2017 Budget (\$1,459,300).

The set millage reflects no increase to the Township tax millage for the 2017 winter tax bill which is used to support our 2018 budget year.

It was further explained that the 2018 Proposed Budget reflects what was discussed at the November 2, 2017 Public Budget Workshop.

Trustee Blank asked questions concerning pay scales.

The Board agreed that it is a fiscally sound Budget proposal and that the Board had adequate time to review the Budget that is being proposed.
