Thank you for participating in Monroe Charter Township's Custer Baseball/Softball summer recreation program. This year we celebrate our 60th year of providing recreation to our youth. As we begin this year, we encourage you to abide by two policies approved by the Monroe Charter Township Board and the Custer Baseball Board. **We ask that all spectators refrain from smoking, except in the designated area near the rock at the north end of the parking lot. We also ask that NO PETS be brought to the ball fields during league play.** Please pass these rules on to any friends or relatives that may come and watch.

Golf cart rides are again available to all diamonds so that elderly or disabled persons may attend games. Please ask at the concession stand for more information.

Coaches and teams will be picked the last week of April. No refunds will be granted after teams have been picked. If your child has not been called by May 19th, please call Monroe Charter Township at 241-5501. Most leagues will begin play the week of June 5th and last approximately 7 weeks. **ONCE TEAMS ARE PICKED NO PLAYERS WILL BE SWITCHED OR MOVED.**

This year only leagues aged 3-8 will be allowed to have up to two special requests. However, these special requests **ARE NOT GUARANTEED!** No special requests will be allowed in the other leagues. Siblings can be requested to play together and son/daughter of team coach and one assistant coach can play together. In order to make these older teams more competitive we are trying to divide up "pitchers" among all the teams. Please check the box if your son/daughter is a pitcher.

As in the past, the Custer Baseball/Softball Organization will operate a concession stand. We encourage you to support this fundraiser. On June 3rd we will have our 9th Annual Opening Day festival.
